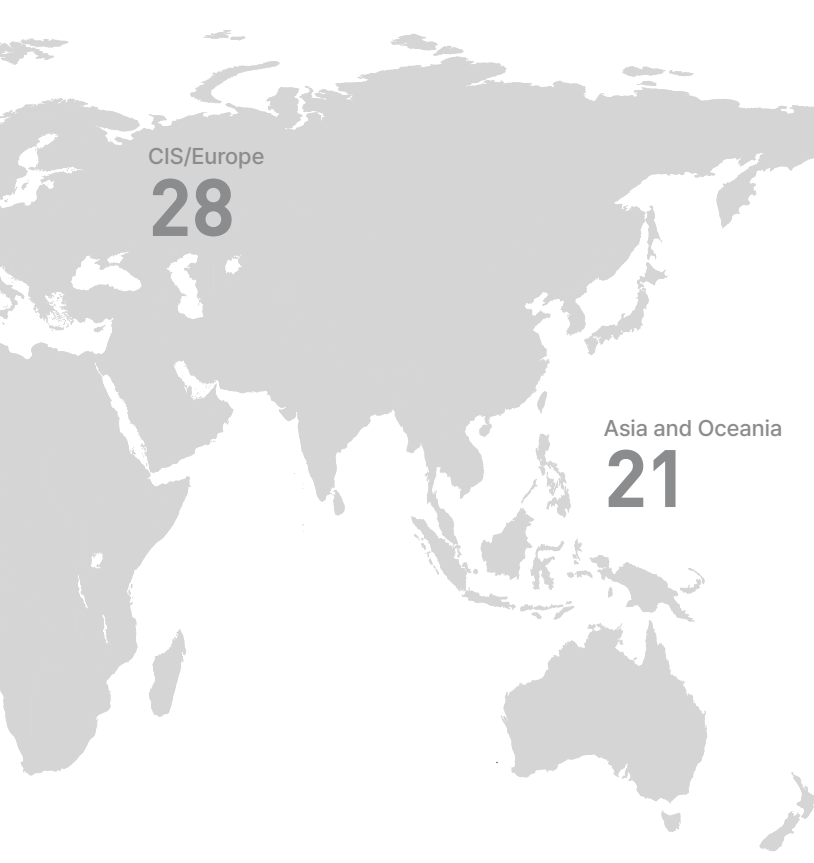

Launched in 2004, the KSP is a knowledge-based economic cooperation program supporting policy design and innovation in partner countries, drawing on Korea's development experience. KSP continues to evolve into a global collaboration platform, advancing knowledge co-creation in the age of digital and AI transformation.

Key Project Cycle

Launching Seminar and High-level Meeting <i>(in partner country)</i>	- Meetings with partner ministries (high-level officials), relevant institutions, and experts - Finalization of project scope and detailed implementation plans
Policy Seminar and In-depth Study <i>(in partner country)</i>	Field research and interviews relevant to subtopics
Interim Reporting Workshop and Policy practitioners' Workshop <i>(in Korea)</i>	- Project participants' visit to Korea; meetings with relevant institutions - Review of project progress through interim reporting sessions
Senior Policy Dialogue and Final Reporting Workshop <i>(in partner country)</i>	- Presentation and discussion of final project results - Sharing key findings through high-level policy dialogue
End-of-Project Evaluation and Monitoring	- Review achievement of project objectives - Discussion of follow-up implementation plans and projects
