This booklet presents the main data contained in the publication entitled Uruguay's International Cooperation Progress Report 2017. For the first time, data was collected through the Integrated System of International Cooperation Uruguay (SICI-UY), a software created by AUCI and nurtured by institutions that constitute the National System of International Cooperation.

Information refers to the non-reimbursable international cooperation for development initiatives executed in 2016 in which Uruguay was either provider, recipient or both. Reported initiatives involved the participation of one or more national public bodies or were granted by international organizations, multilateral and bilateral funds and other countries' public bodies.

The adoption of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development urges us to aim for an integral and equitable international cooperation system, based on solidarity among all countries according to each one's capabilities, that leaves no one behind. In this context, the data shows that Uruguay retains a dual role in the international cooperation arena. On the one hand, it still requires support in some strategic areas for its sustainable development. On the other hand, the country is already contributing to the achievement of the 2030 Agenda by sharing its most successful public policies with the rest of the region.




