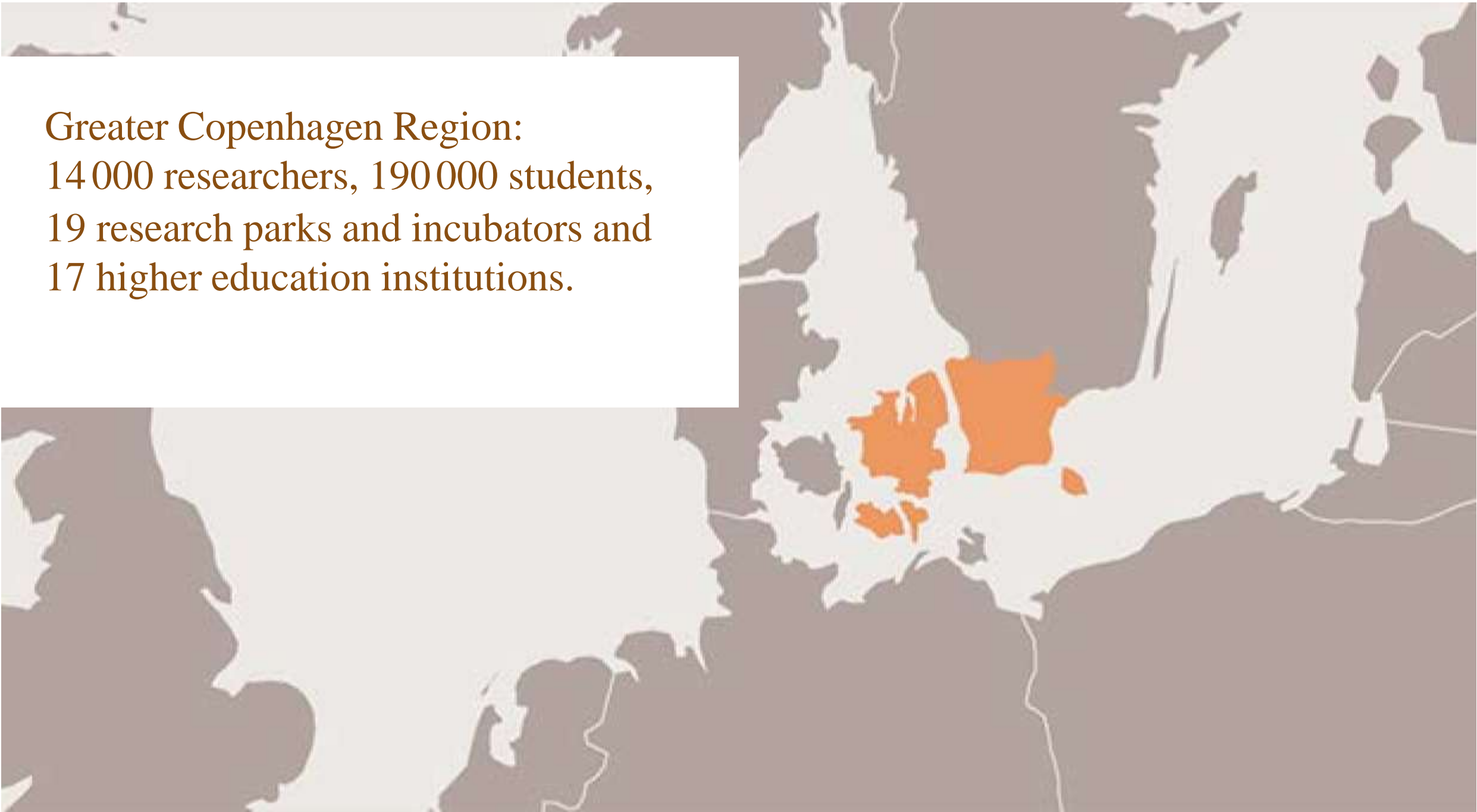


# SWEDEN

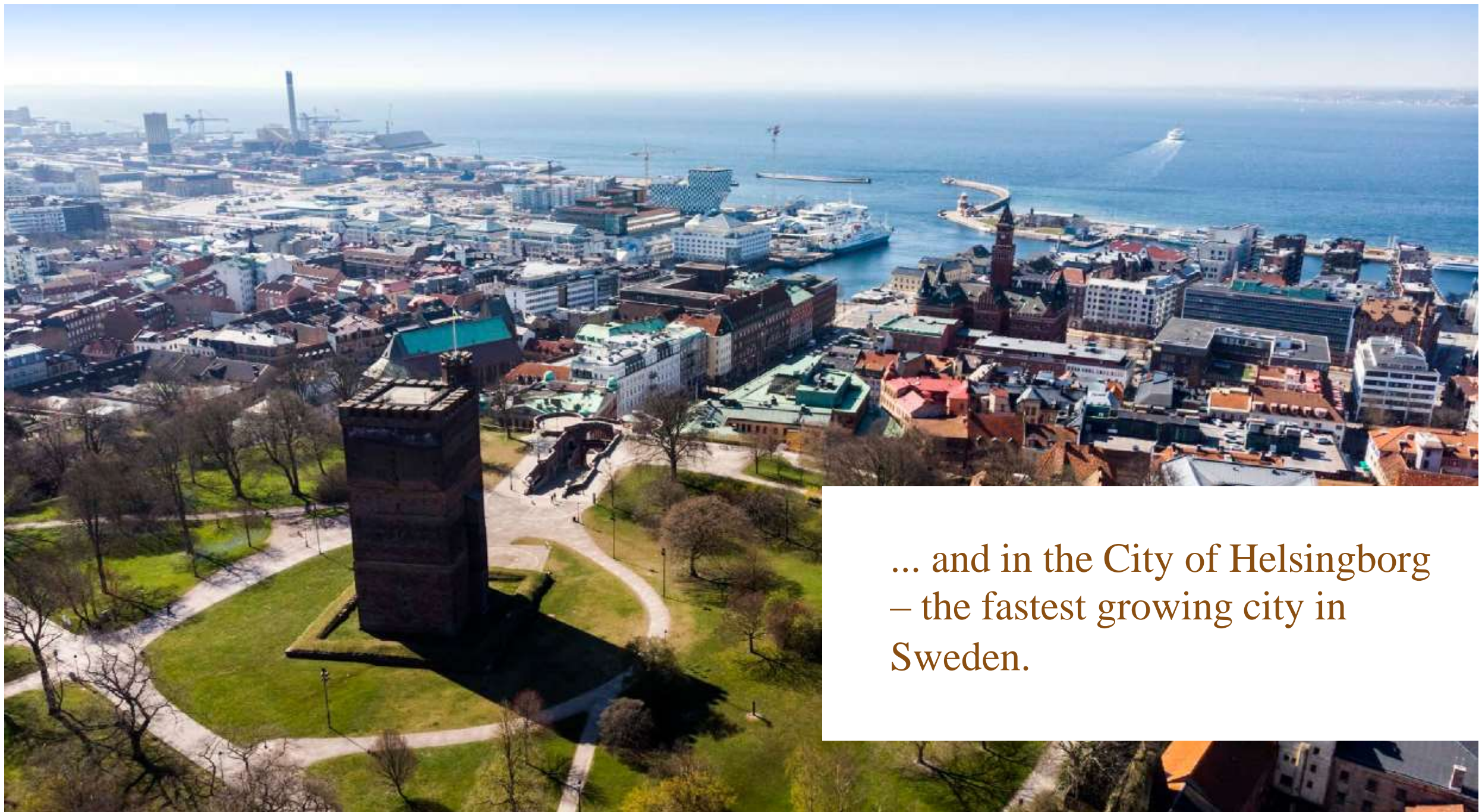

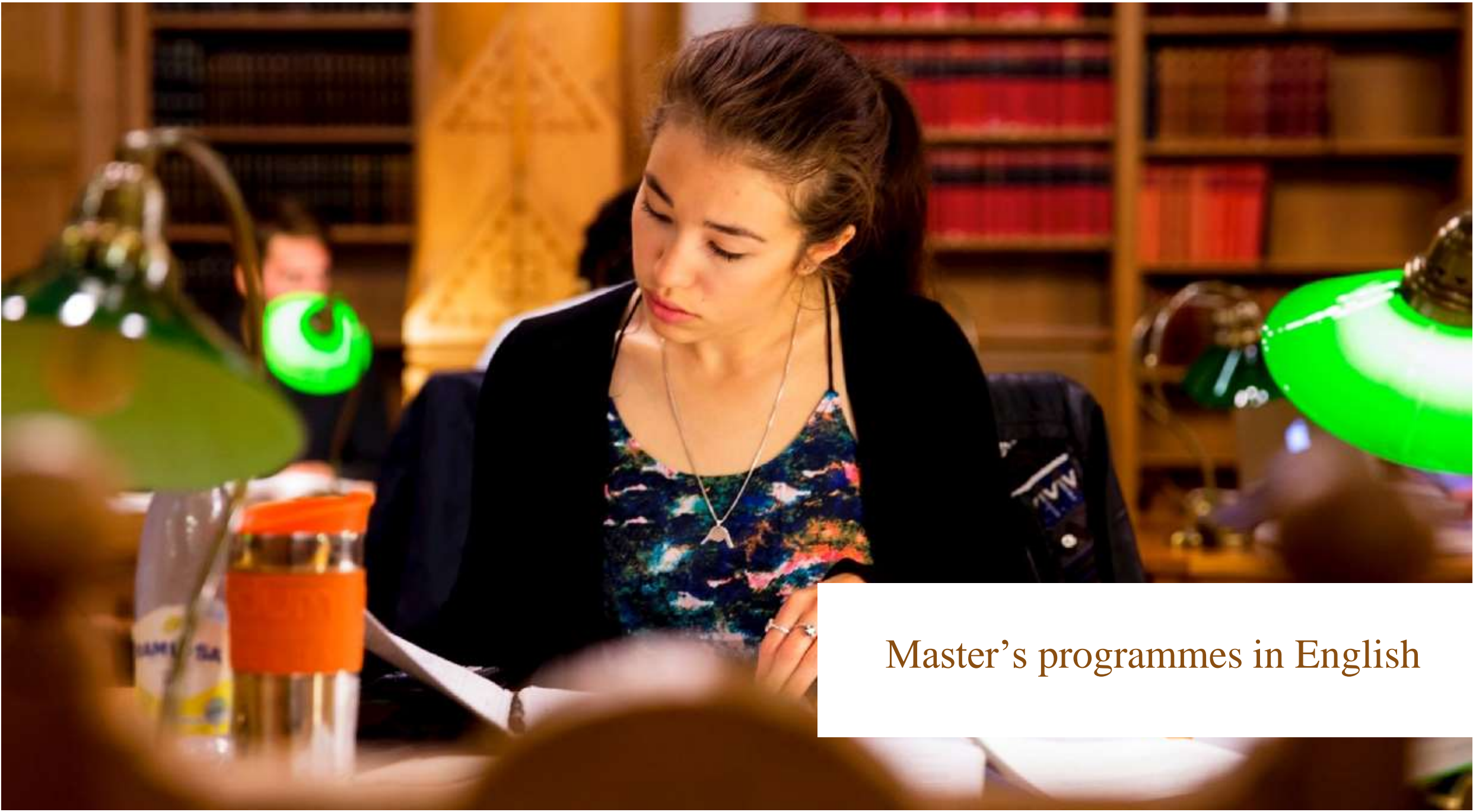

# Master's degree programmes

- We offer over 130 Master's programmes taught in English
- Wide range of subject areas
- Most programmes are 2 years in duration, some are 1 year
- Course/module-based
- Conclude with a thesis or degree project



# Master's degree programmes

- All Master's prepare you for a PhD and continued research career
- Programmes based on current research & connected to industry/business/society
- Opportunity to tailor coursework with electives offered in many programmes
- Internship or Study Abroad option for some programmes (640 partner universities worldwide)



# Master's entry requirements

- Completed Bachelor's degree (you can apply during final year)
- English proficiency
- Most programmes require previous studies/major in the subject (sometimes even specific courses)
- Some programmes open to any previous studies/major
- No GRE or GMAT requirement for entry to LU programmes



# Master's studies admission

- Competitive admission – you must meet all the entry requirements **and** be selected
- Selection criteria varies between programmes
- Check the tab “requirements and selection” on the programme webpages

Non-EU citizens are required to pay tuition. Have a plan early on for how to fund your studies!

# Tuition fees (Master's studies)

- **Humanities, social sciences:** USD 12,800 per year
- **Business:** USD 14,000-15,000 per year
- **Engineering, Science, Environment:** USD 17,500 per year
- **Biomedicine/Medical Science/Public Health:** USD 16,300-21,000 per year
- **Architecture, Fine Art:** USD 24,500 per year

**USD prices approximate**



# Living costs

## **Example of recommended monthly budget:**

- Food: USD 275
- Accommodation: USD 375-560
- Course literature: USD 45-115
- Miscellaneous expenses such as clothing, mobile phone, leisure activities, etc.:  
USD 175

**Note:** You must have the funding for your living costs, approximately USD 1000/per month for your study period before coming to Sweden.

# Scholarships for non-EU citizens

- The largest scholarship programme in Sweden: **The Lund University Global Scholarship**
- Selective and merit-based
- Covers partial tuition (generally 25%-90%)

These scholarships will be open for applications in early February, for students who have made a complete application for studies (submitted all required documents and paid the application fee).



# Funding agreement with ANII

- Special agreement for students who receive funding with ANII to study certain subjects
- Up to three students will receive a 25% scholarship from Lund University
- Scholarship is deducted from the tuition fees
- Insurance included
- Students have a housing guarantee

# Application deadlines!

- **Mid-October** is when we open for applications every year
- **15 January** is deadline to select your programmes via [www.universityadmissions.se](http://www.universityadmissions.se) and rank them in order of preference
- **1 February** is the deadline for all documents to be **correctly** received and for the application fee to be paid/or to prove exempt

- Choose one or several programmes
- Rank your programmes in the order you most want
- Submit all supporting documents following the country rules
- Don't forget the program-specific documents!
- Pay the application fee or prove exemption
