



OPPORTUNITY PAVILION AGI ARCHITECTS

The visitor experience is based on a series of moments that will challenge the visitor's thinking on issues related to basic needs of water, food, and energy by simulating environments of real life individuals who are agents of change in their own communities.



MOBILITY PAVILION FOSTER & PARTNERS

SUSTAINABILITY PAVILION GRIMSHAW ARCHITECTS

Creating its own electricity and water, with more than 1055 solar panels, this pavilion features global projects that are charting new paths for sustainability.



PARTICIPANT PAVILIONS



Inspired by the 'Rock of Monaco', this gem-like, polygonal pavilion will take visitors on a multi-sensory journey through mirrored exhibition spaces, replicating the sights and smells of the French Riviera.



Immerse yourself in Montenegro's rich cultural history, explore its sustainability-driven future, and admire its wild beauty.



Enjoy a sensory experience through one of the cradles of mankind and one of the most biodiverse countries in the world. See a real-time construction of the last Incan bridge and treat yourself to Peruvian superfoods.



The pavilion is designed to resemble a coral reef or 'Bangkóta', focusing on the vital need to safeguard precious marine life across thousands of islands in the Philippines from global climate change.

OPPORTUNITY MOBILITY SUSTAINABILITY



Morocco is a land rich in talent, full of opportunities and a source of inspiration. Enjoy one of the best views of Expo from atop this vertical earthen village and explore its various exhibition areas.



Showcasing Myanmar's significant culture, deep history and values of its people, the pavilion incorporates unique wooden architecture.



The tree-like structure, which references the large-scale migration of birds from Poland to the Arab world, explores the nation's diverse global connections, and its role as a leading producer of goods.



The Portugal Pavilion will highlight the human spirit through the diversity and inclusiveness of its people, reflect the culture of creativity and innovation, and reveal an ecosystem of great opport unities.



Achieving sustainable solutions through out-of-the-box creativity, this pavilion takes you to a miniature world with its own climate system. Experience new Dutch farming ideas with indoor rain and a verticalfarm.



Reflecting the Maori value of 'kaitiakitanga', the pavilion emphasises the deep kinship between people and the environment. Maori culture is also highlighted through the pavilion's architecture.



Get a chance to see what future minds will be able to achieve. This pavilion will give you the opportunity to see inside yourself and offers a wide range of modern Russiancuisines.



Covering an area of the size of two football pitches, the pavilion resembles a huge window opening up from the ground and soaring into the sky. Expect an immersive journey showing the country's glittering future.



Explore the deep blue sea and learn about the importance of ocean conservation as well as Norway's seafaring heritage. Embark on an interactive journey from beneath the seabed to the water's surface.



Oman's pavilion will give you an enchanting experience inspired by frankincense. The five zones within the pavilion will take you through thousands of years of Omani progress and international collaboration.

Austria is a nation reimagining ideas. This is reflected in its decision to use 9,000-year-old soil to build its pavilion. The 38 shiny white cones are inspired by the Arab model of wind towers.



As one of the largest pavilions at Expo 2020 Dubai, China will symbolise hope and a bright future. The pavilion artistically integrates the Chinese elements with modern technologies.



Experience the magic of Comoros. Come play with humpback whales, rare turtles and the famous coelacanth, one of the rarest fish in the whole world. Smell ylang-ylang, the flower that revolutionised perfume.

Centered around a five-storey waterfall installation to inspire and reflect, the DP Pavilion creates an immersive 270-degree experience showing the transformative power of data inhow we live and work.



Experience the Future of Commercial Aviation in UAE's Centennial Year 2071. A technically advanced, must-see opportunity to learn, experiment and engage withfuture technologies and innovations in airtravel.



Given that the world's largest river runs through Brazil, it's no surprise that the pavilion incorporates water as its most striking feature, evoking the Amazon basin in the Dubai desert.




